FEBRUARY MEETING HIGHLIGHTS

Secretary & Treasurer's report were accepted as read.

Old Business—The banquet was successful, the auction went smoothly and a little quicker than it has in past years. A suggestion was made that instead of having volunteers selling auction and 50/50 ticket we should sell them at the door next year. Paul thanked Pete Gevinski and Joe Weller for coming out early and helping set-up

New Business—Paul presented a list of all APBA stock, mod & pro races (listed below) After reviewing the list this left 6 dates open for EORC races without clashes except for Crystal Lake. Two dates in August (9th & 16th) are also available but those present agreed not to put on any races in August since they are so poorly attended in the past.

These are tentative dates subject to tide charts. Howie will get charts from the Town in the Spring. Cost of racing is approximately \$1500. Paul stated that he will cancel any race that has a poor turnout. Discussion was then held about pre-registration so the club knows in advance how many entries can be expected. The following is what is being presented to the membership.

EORC Stimulus Package

Two race days will be run on one day of racing. This means four (4) heats for each class. Advance registration will be accepted up to the Friday one week preceding the race (about 10 days prior);

Advance registration only will be \$35 for one class and \$15 for additional classes

Race day registration will be \$40 for one class and \$15 for additional classes.

No refunds will be made unless the race is cancelled or upon approval of the membership. If a race is cancelled registration will be applied to the next schedule race.

Howie advises that we have not paid our AOF dues of \$75 as of this date. Howie feels we should maintain our AOF membership. Paul advised that Our insurance (Clancy & Clancy) have been providing good services for many years and is very cooperative. Cost is approximately \$2000 per season.

Our next meeting is March 19th at Blue Point Recreation Center. If you have any input March 19th is the time to be heard.
